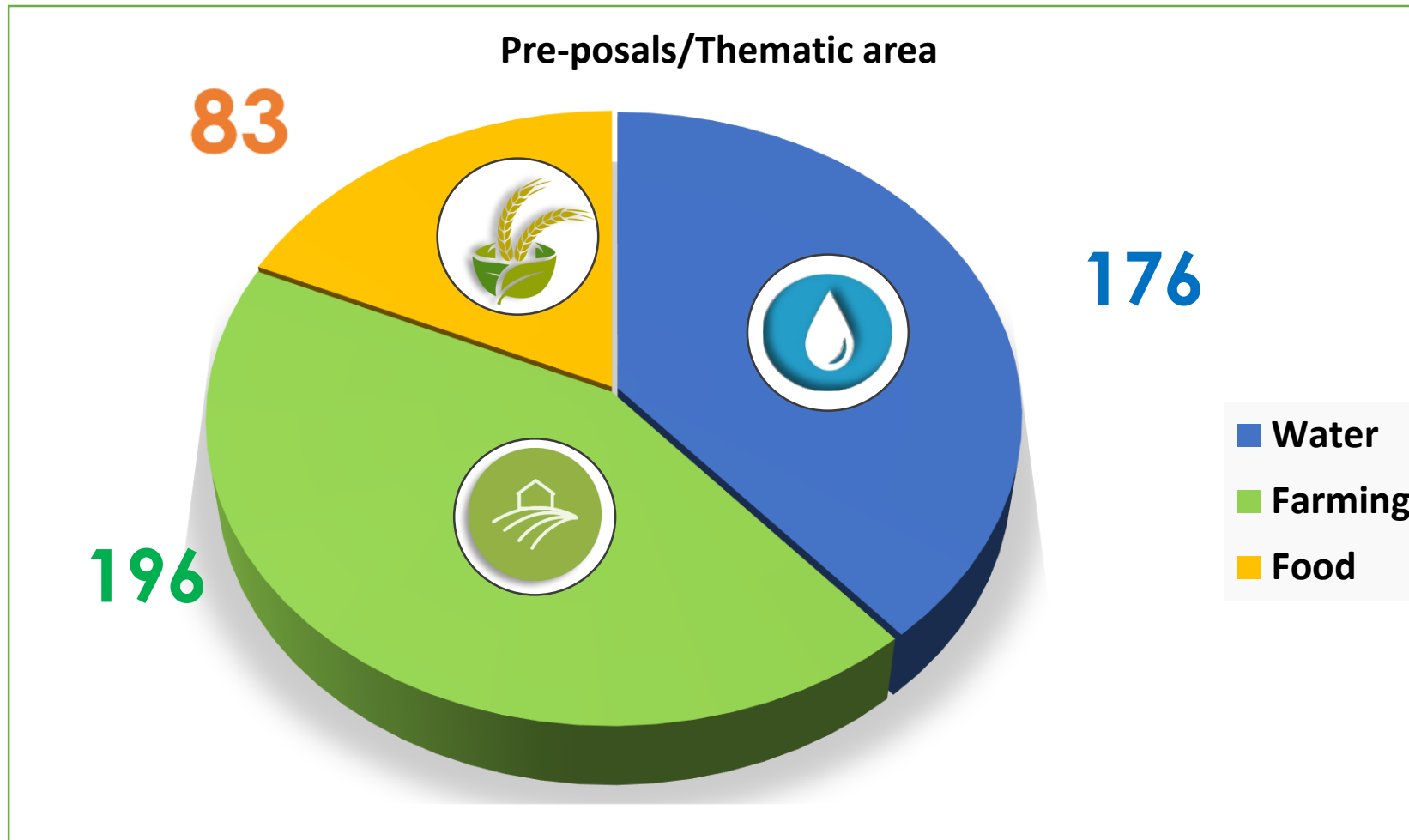

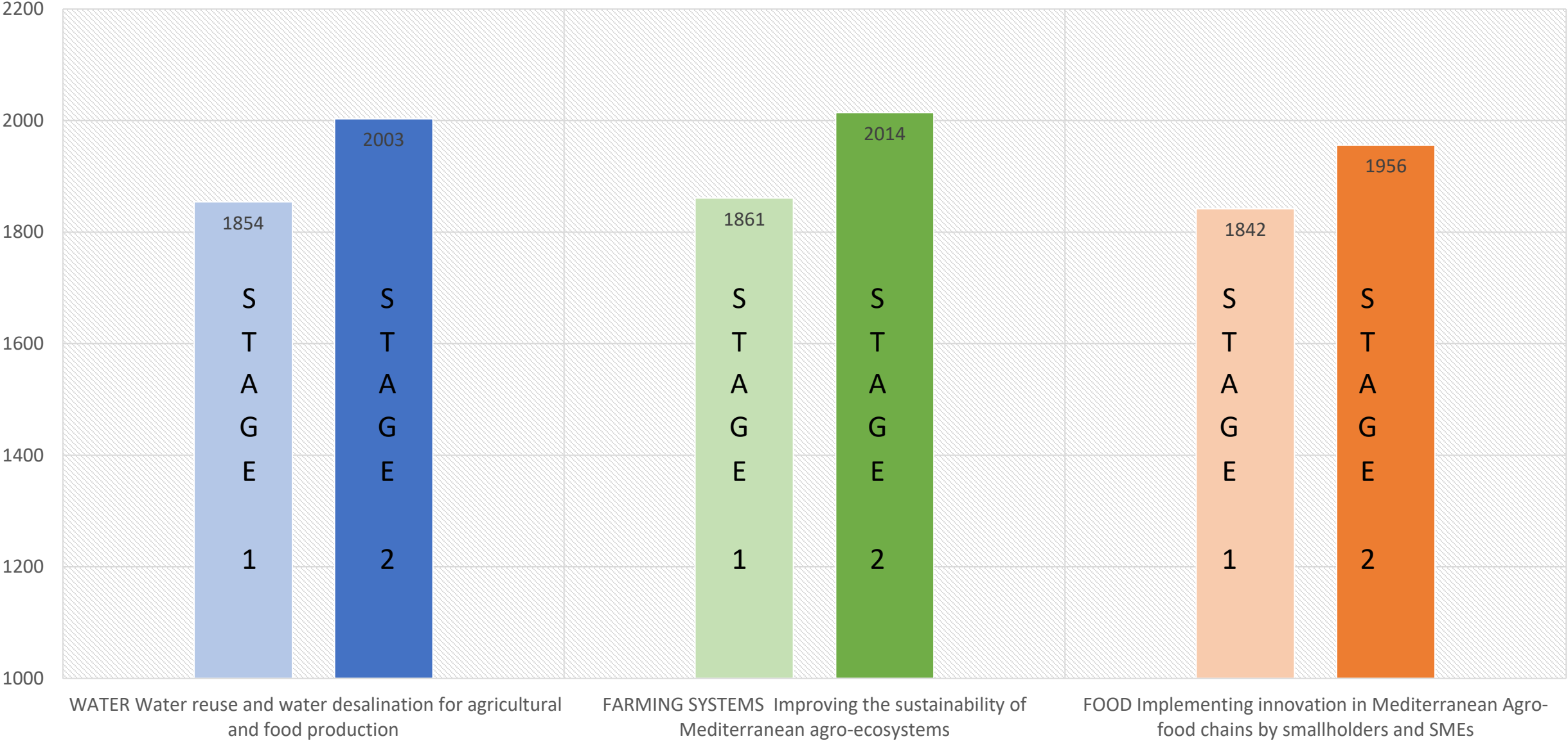

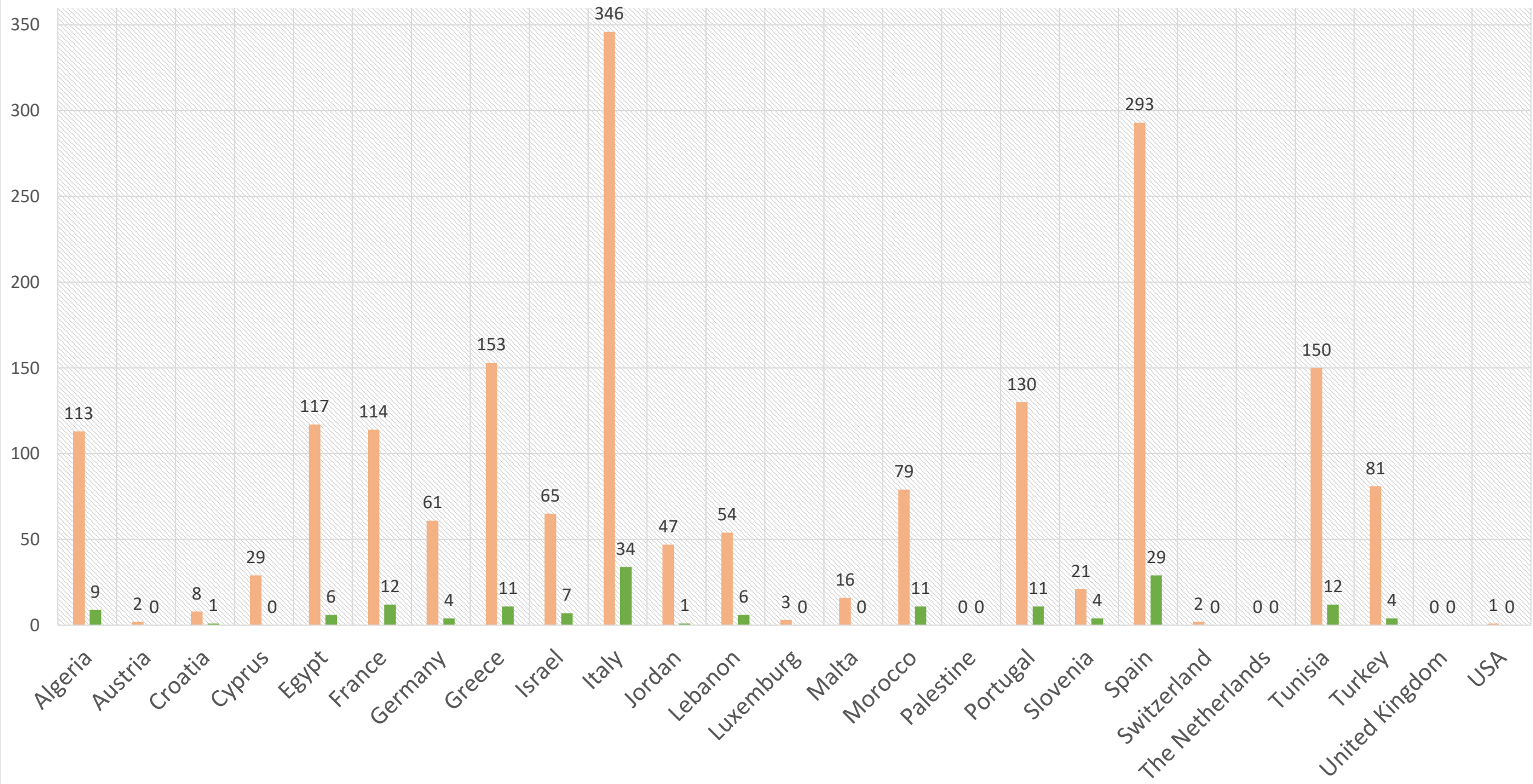
# Section 1 Pre-proposals submitted/Thematic area



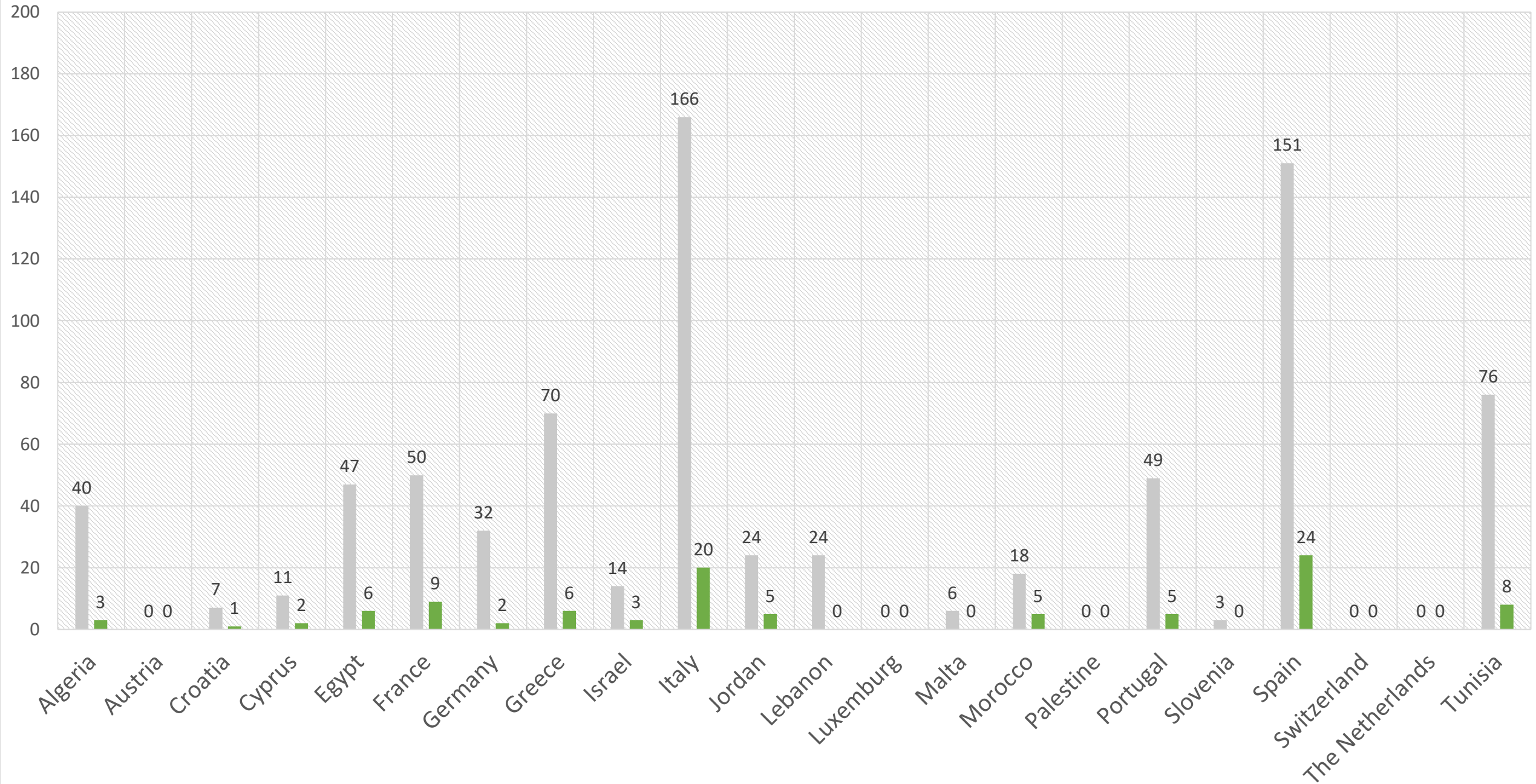
# Section 1 Mean Budget/proposal (in K€)



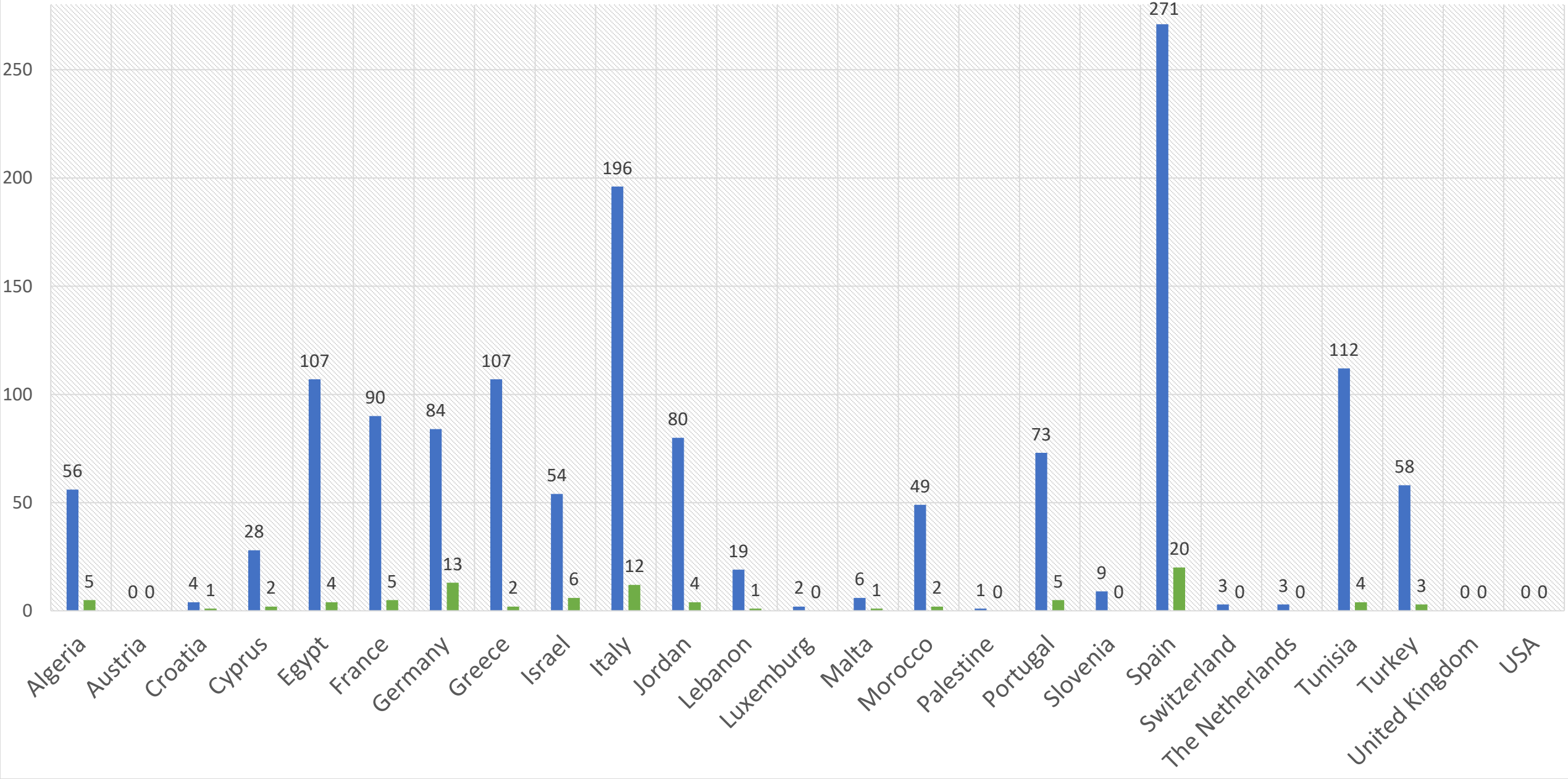
# Total Number of Participants Section 1 Farming : Stage 1= 1885 / Stage 2= 162



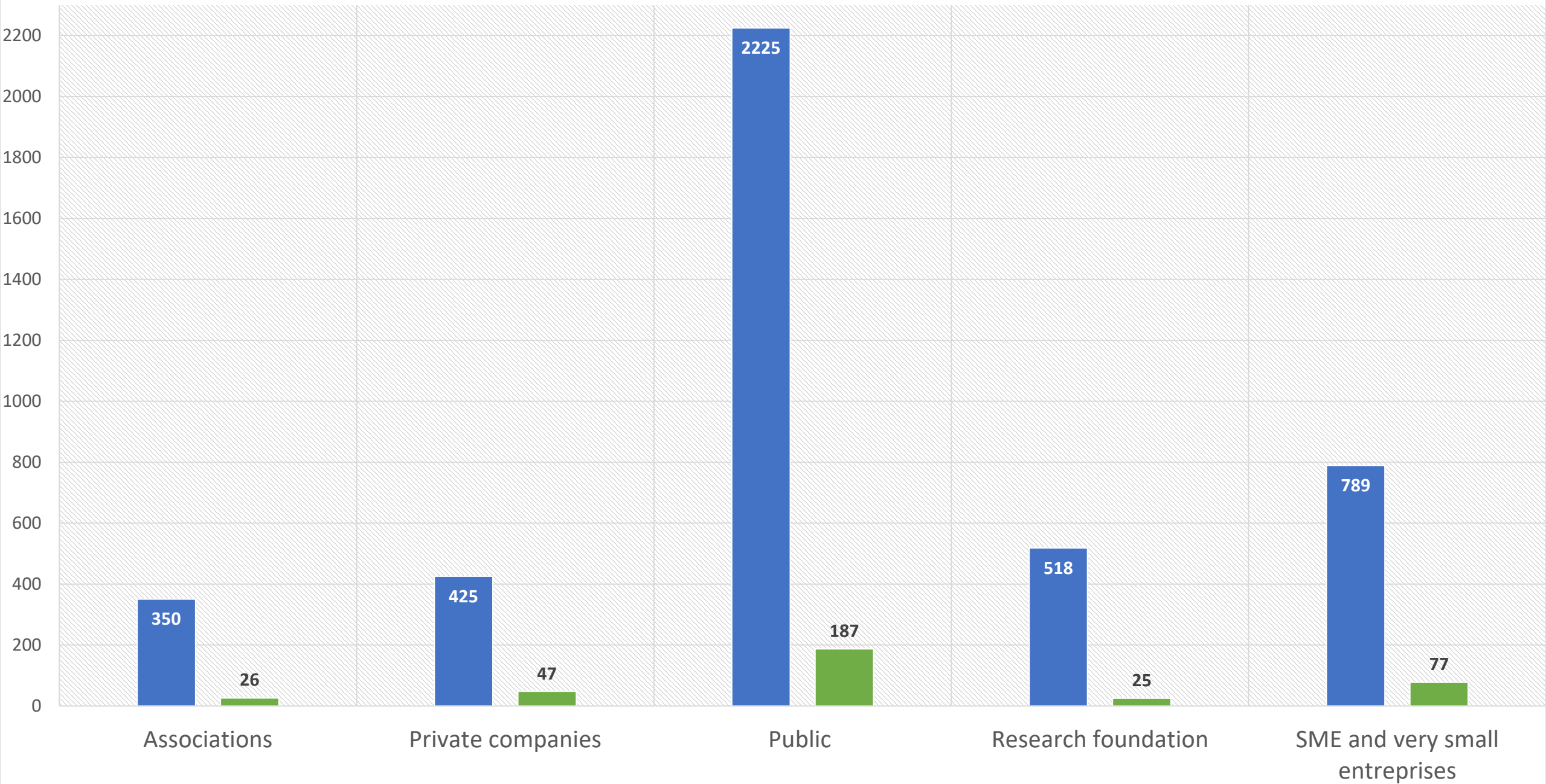
# Total number of participants Section 1 Agro Food :Stage 1= 830/Stage 2= 110

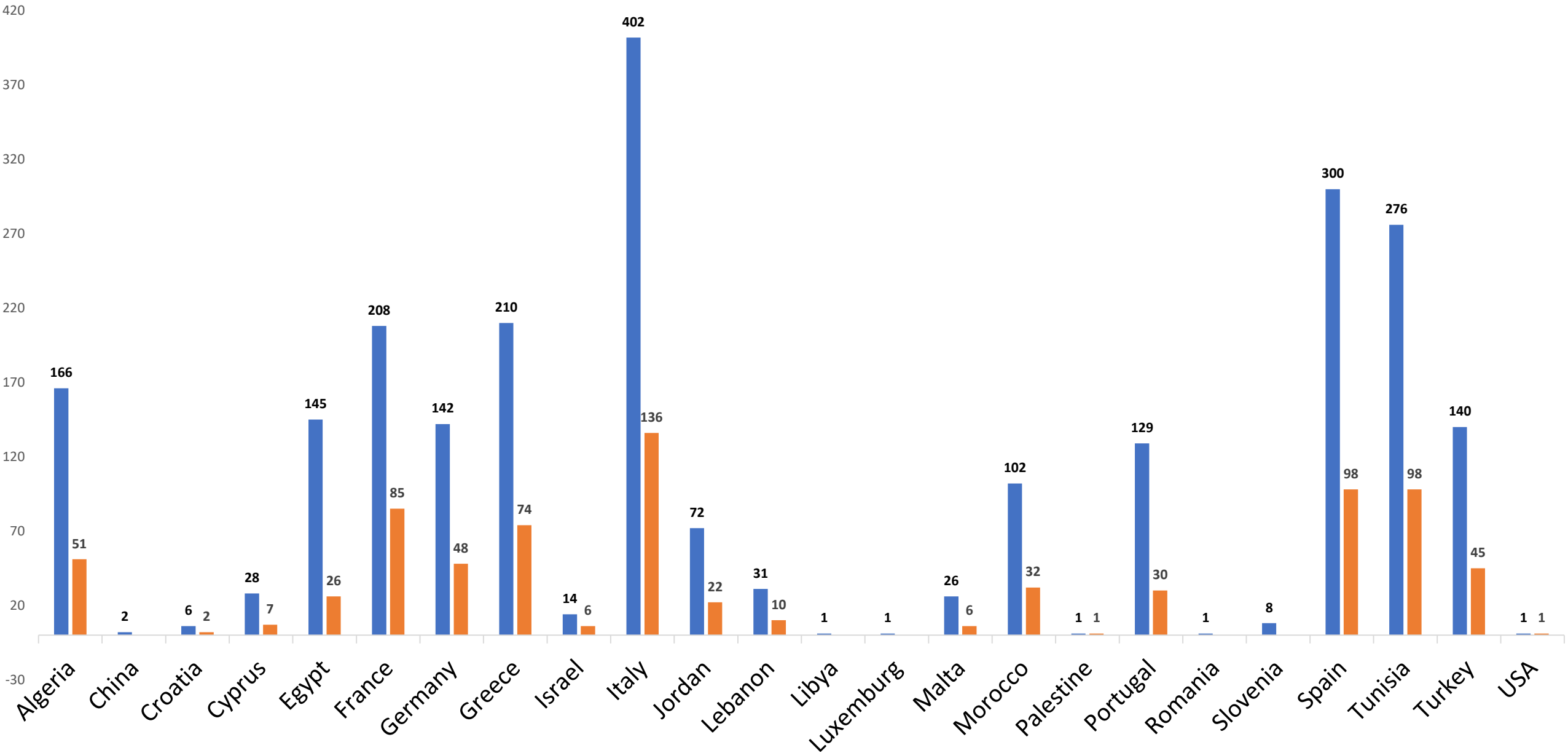

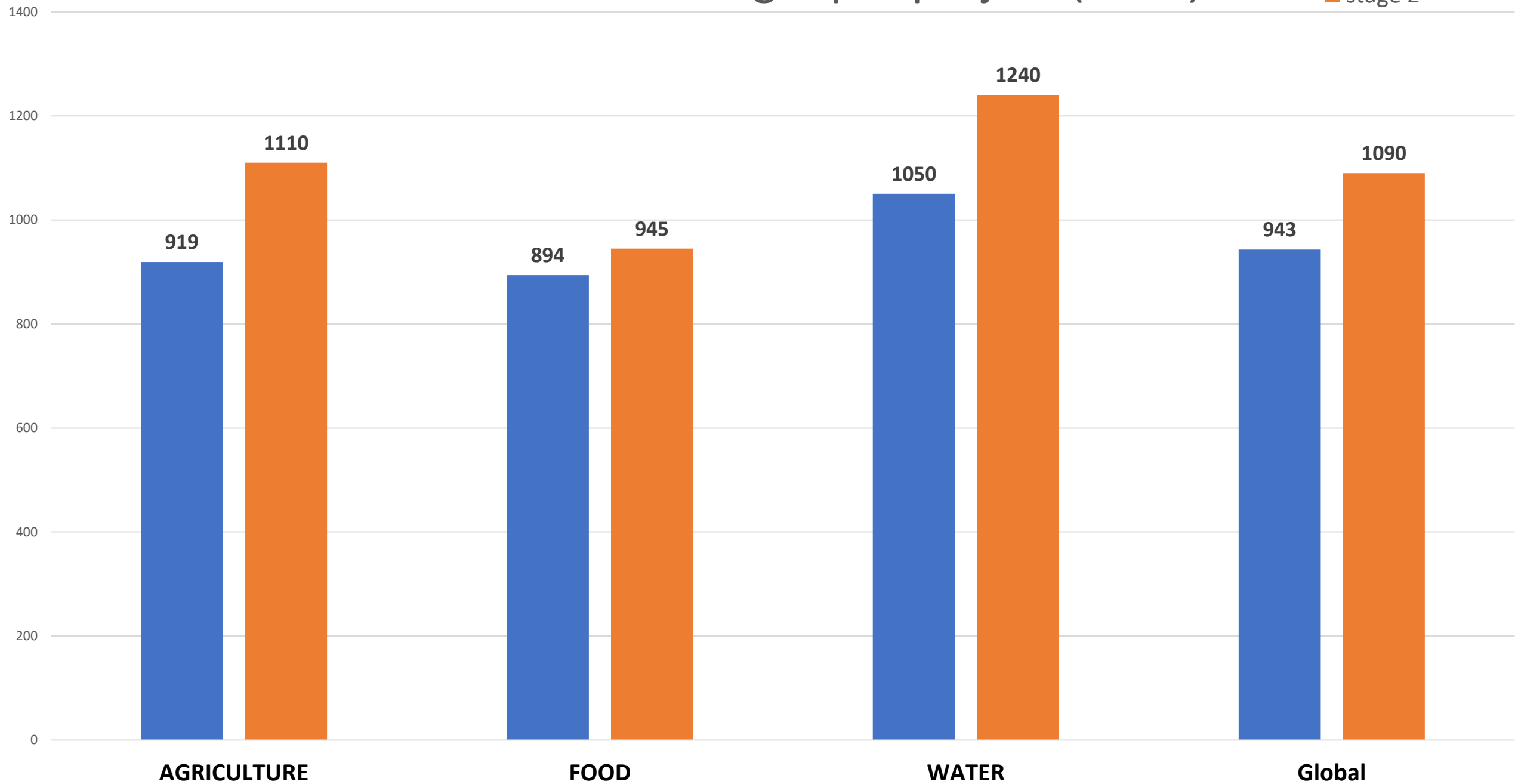

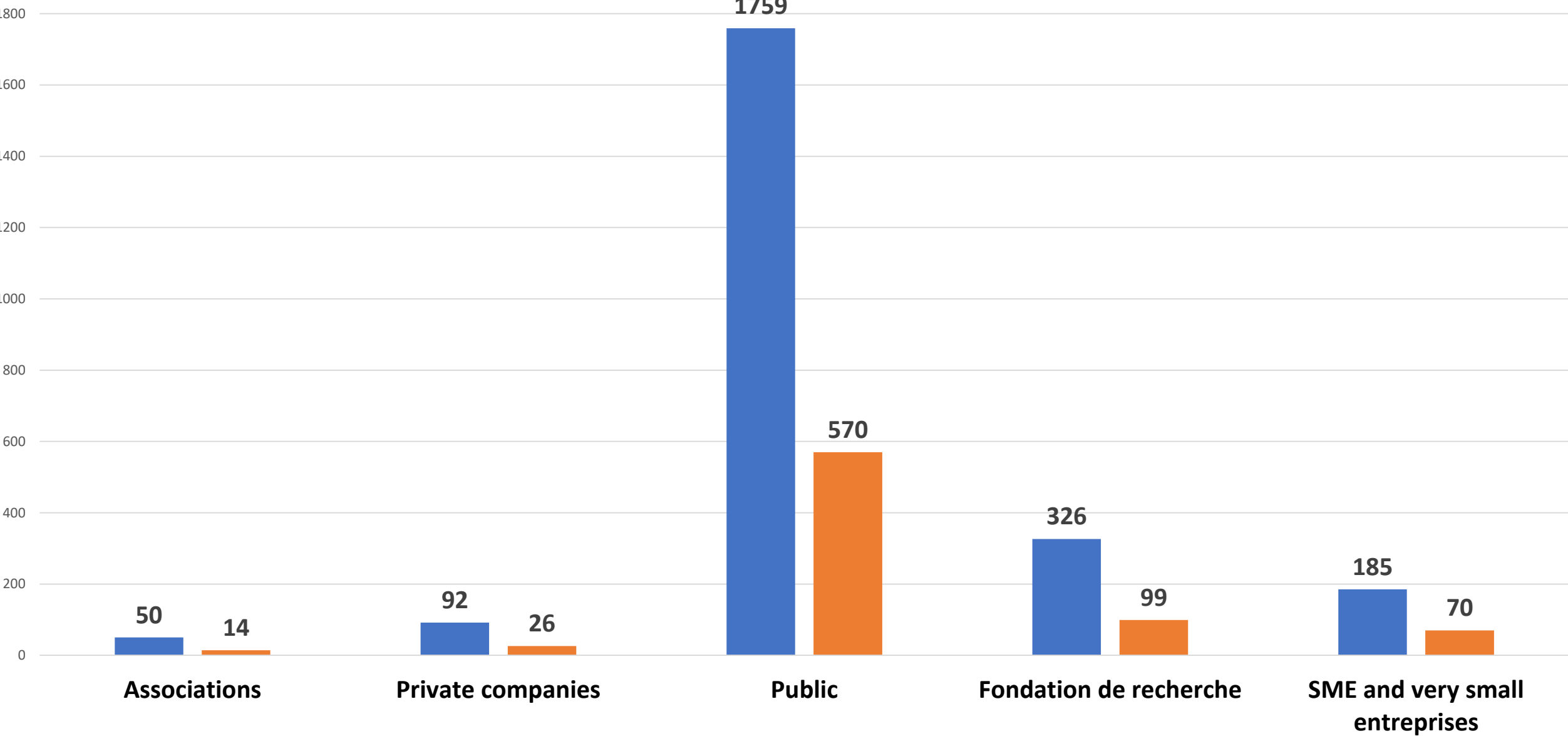
## Section 2: Mean Budget per project (in K€)

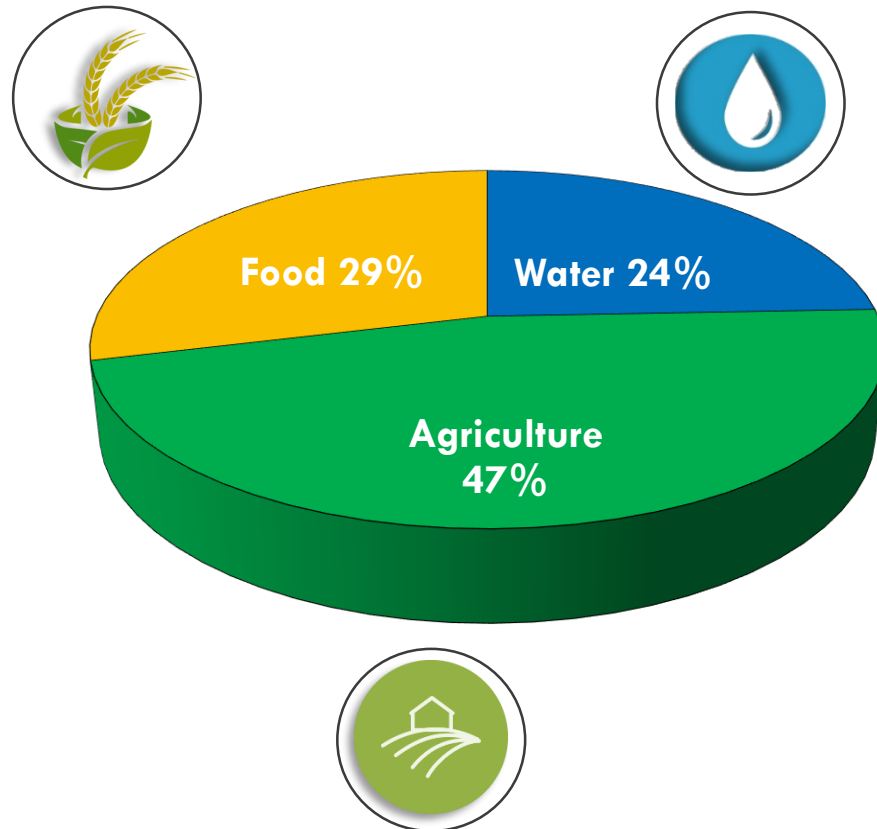


# Type of Institutions Section 2

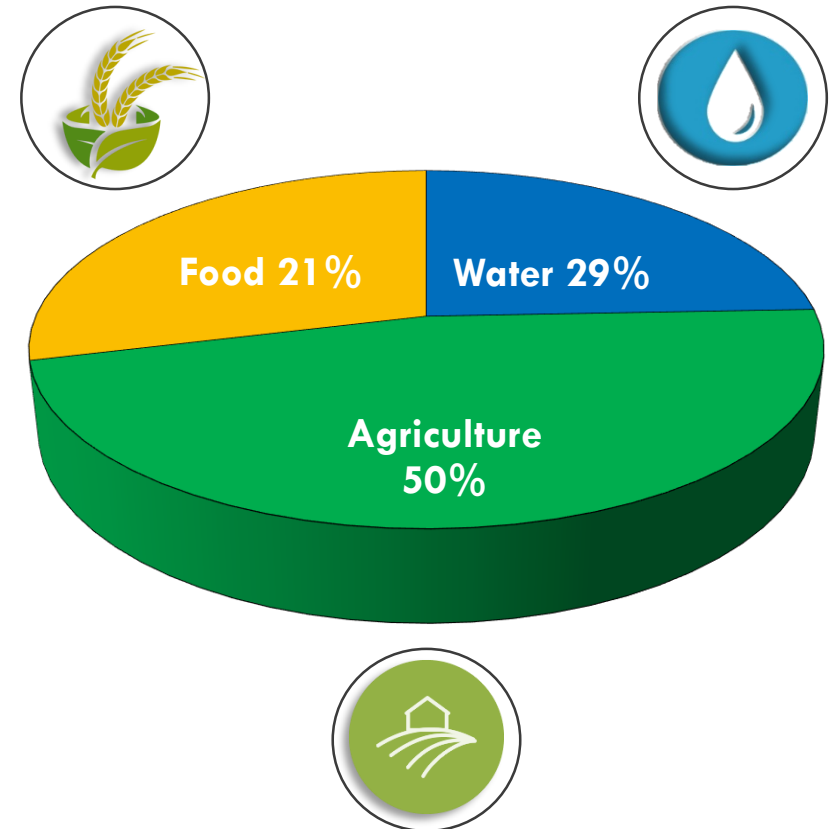
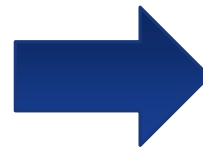

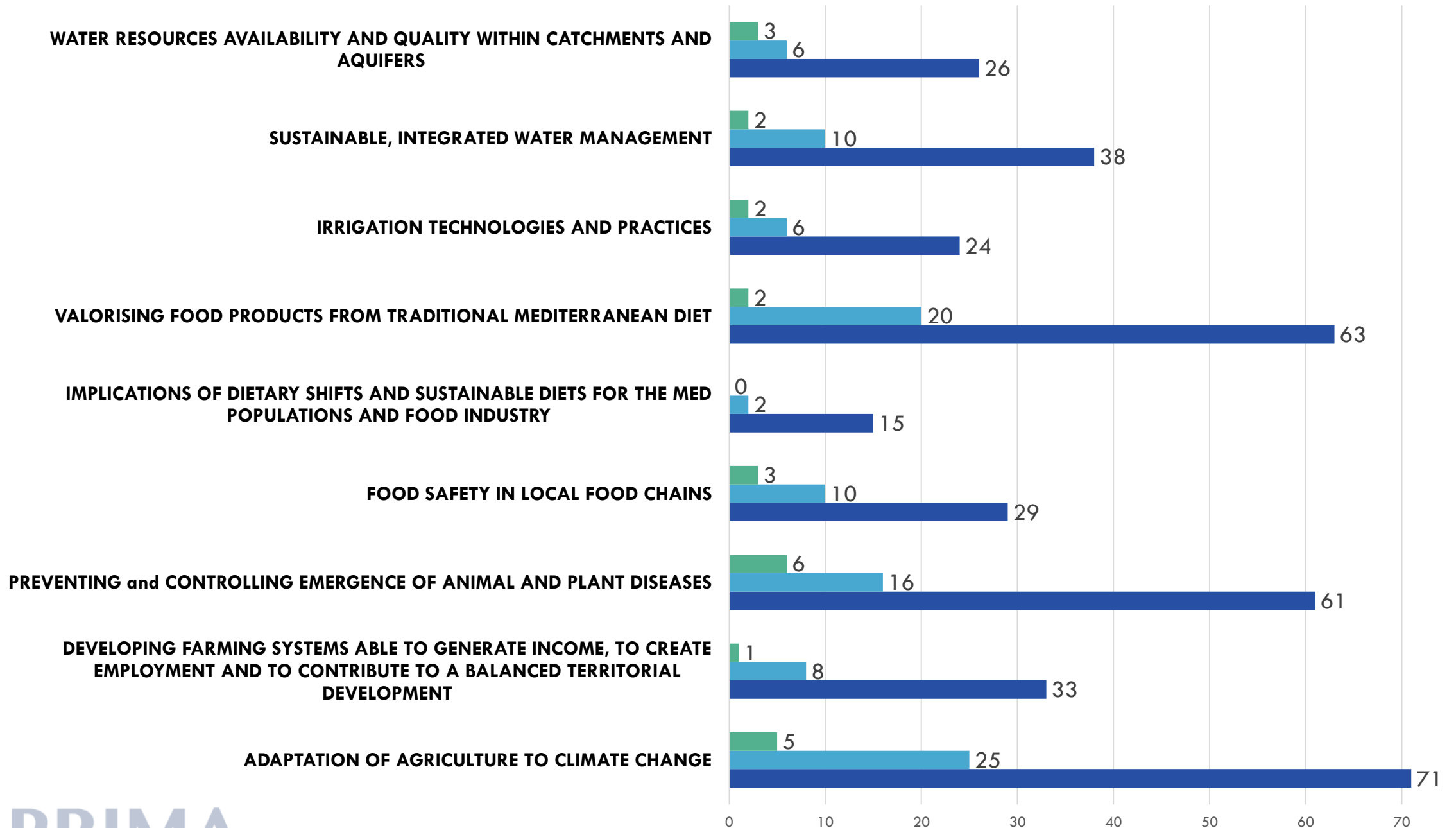
